for the water and nutrients that help the tree stay alive!

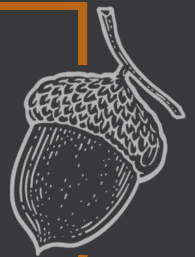
The tallest trees in the world are Redwoods, commonly found in North America.
