Principal Accountabilities

- 1. Carry out various fabric tasks including painting & decorating, plastering repairs, joinery, and other general maintenance tasks.
- 2. Have knowledge of basic electrical and plumbing maintenance tasks.
- 3. Support the Maintenance and Facilities Engineer by carrying out a variety of preventative and reactive maintenance on a day-to-day basis.
- 4. Assist with testing and safety checks such as fire alarm, emergency lighting and generator test.
- 5. Complete work assigned on Web'T' cards, keeping the Maintenance and Facilities Engineer up to date with job progress and completion.
- 6. Help to maintains pools and associated plants. Ensure the correct maintenance of water chemistry across all pools and specifically respond to abnormal readings and correct to prescribed tolerances.
- 7. Assist with grounds maintenance.
- 8. Work co-operatively with other team members to ensure that maintenance issues are attended to promptly.
- 9. Maintain up to date knowledge of health and safety requirements and ensure they are adhered to.
- 10. Maintain the highest standards of tidiness and cleanliness in all work areas, both internally and externally, so that the best possible impression is given to guests.
- 11. Report any accidents, or health and safety risks immediately.
- 12. Must be able to work with some degree of flexibility in terms of hours, as certain works can only be carried out when the business is closed.
